Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the State of Connecticut Health and Educational Facilities Authority (the "Authority"), on January 25, 2010 commencing at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Authority, 10 Columbus Boulevard, 7th Floor, Hartford, Connecticut 06106-1978, for the purpose of providing a reasonable opportunity for interested individuals to express their views, either orally or in writing, on the issuance of the above-captioned tax-exempt obligation and the nature of the equipment and/or other personal property described below. The Authority has been requested to make available the proceeds of the above-captioned Lease and Sublease in the aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,450,000.00, to be used by The Hospital of Central Connecticut at New Britain General and Bradley Memorial (the "Institution"), a non-profit institution duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Connecticut, to provide moneys for the purpose of financing all or a portion of the costs of capital expenditures for (i) the acquisition and installation of a 1.2 Tesla Open Magnetic Resonance Imaging ("MRI") Scanner, and MRI Stretcher and an MRI Injector as well as other related medical equipment, (ii) certain buildouts to accommodate such medical equipment, and (iii) certain financing costs at the Institution's facilities located at 81 Meriden Avenue, Southington, Connecticut 06489.

Interested members of the public are invited to attend. Individuals desiring to make a brief statement regarding the foregoing projects should give prior notice in writing to the Authority at the address shown below at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Written comments may be submitted to the Authority at the address shown below.
