MASTER FINANCING AGREEMENT
FOR THE BENEFIT OF HARTFORD HOSPITAL

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the State of Connecticut Health and Educational Facilities Authority (the "Authority"), on June 16, 2010 commencing at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Authority, 10 Columbus Boulevard, 7th Floor, Hartford, Connecticut 06106-1978, for the purpose of providing a reasonable opportunity for interested individuals to express their views, either orally or in writing, on the issuance of the above-captioned tax-exempt obligation and the nature of the equipment and/or other personal property described below. The Authority has been requested to make available the proceeds of the above-captioned Master Financing Agreement in the aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$20,000,000, in one or more series or issues, to be used by Hartford Hospital (the "Institution"), a non-profit institution duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Connecticut, to provide moneys for the purpose of financing all or a portion of the costs of capital expenditures for (i) the acquisition of a Lifestar Helicopter, including fitout; (ii) the acquisition of certain hospital equipment, including surgical robots, ultrasound machines, dialysis machines, Large Bore Radiation Oncology CT, 64 Slice CT Scan, Cardiology PET CT, Institute of Living MRI, O-Arm Imaging System for Radiology and other imaging equipment, Digital Radiology System Conversion, Psych MRU, patient beds, Physician EMR, Personal Computers, CBO Denial Management Software, Patient Clinical Information Systems, a DMX Storage System, telephone system upgrades, nurse call system and electrical infrastructure upgrade in Conklin, including an emergency generator, and chillers, including certain buildouts to accommodate such equipment, and (iii) certain financing costs at the Institution's facilities located at 80 Seymour Street and at 400 Washington Street, both in Hartford, Connecticut 06102.

Interested members of the public are invited to attend. Individuals desiring to make a brief statement regarding the foregoing projects should give prior notice in writing to the Authority at the address shown below at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Written comments may be submitted to the Authority at the address shown below.
