

# State of Connecticut Health and Educational Facilities Authority

## Minutes of Public Hearing 2010-12

September 7, 2010

A public hearing of the State of Connecticut Health and Educational Facilities Authority (the "Authority") concerning the public approval of projects to be financed by loans from the Authority to the University of Bridgeport (the "Institution"), with the proceeds of a bond issue of the Authority at the Authority's office at 10 Columbus Boulevard, Seventh Floor, Hartford, Connecticut was held on September 7, 2010.

The hearing was called to order by Michael F. Morris, Assistant Director and Presiding Officer of the Authority, at 10:00 a.m. at the place and on the date indicated above pursuant to the notices published on August 21, 2010 in the Hartford Courant and August 23, 2010 in the Connecticut Post, and August 26, 2010 in La Voz Hispana. In addition to Mr. Morris, Jeanette Weldon and Jennifer Smyth of the Authority and Nancy L. Hadley, of Bridgeport, were present.

The Presiding Officer ordered the Notice of Public Hearing spread upon the minutes of this hearing and filed for record.

The Presiding Officer determined that Ms. Hadley of the general public not related to the Authority had appeared and stated that neither the Presiding Officer nor the Authority had received any communication from interested parties requesting any change in time or postponement of the hearing or time to speak.

The Presiding Officer informed Ms. Hadley of the Procedures for the TEFRA Hearing for the University of Bridgeport Issue, Series C.

Ms. Hadley explained that she was attending the hearing after reading about the project in an article that appeared in the Connecticut Post. She stated that she is very supportive of the University and the project, saying that it will benefit not only the University, but the area around the campus and the city in general.

The Presiding Officer determined to allow additional time for the public to appear and held the meeting open.

No additional members of the public having appeared, and there being no other business to be presented at the hearing, the Presiding Officer adjourned the meeting at 10:30 a.m.
